Dear Brethren,

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Hope Mission Centre continues to enjoy the day to day grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. First term April holidays come to an end on Monday 1st of May 2011, and classes resume on Tuesday 2nd of May 2011 through 5th August 2011; God willing.

The long rains continue and one of our greatest challenges as you can see above is a muddy compound that makes us restrain the movement of our children unless it is very necessary. During hot weather, the compound goes to the other extreme of being quite dusty and again child play is restricted due to contracting dust borne diseases. We're not complaining and neither are we blaming our different seasons as they are important to us, but have tried to contain the problem by planting grass during the school holidays but once school reopens, the children tread on it so it dries up.

The landlord is not willing to pave the compound and so we are opting for concrete paving slabs that we can remove and use in another compound when time comes for relocating the school. This slabs are costing Ksh. 310 per square foot and the total of slabs + installation quote is coming to Ksh. 47,000.

We however keep praying for our own compound.
